BHESCo's pioneering Energy Saving Service

Our Energy Saving Service launched in 2016 to support people with reducing their energy consumption, recognising that the cheapest energy is the energy we don't use. Our bespoke service is designed to quickly identify where a building is wasting heat and power, then to recommend the most cost-effective solutions to remedy any problems. The service is designed to support customers through the entire carbon emission reduction journey.

Our Energy Saving Team have completed almost 1,200 surveys throughout Sussex and Kent, receiving multiple awards and accolades for their dedication, professionalism, and expertise.



Tackling fuel poverty in Brighton & Hove



Brighton and Hove is known as an affluent city which attracts 11 million tourists each year to its museums, festivals, and beaches. Less renowned is the high level of deprivation in the city with an estimated 16,000 households unable to adequately heat and power their homes. BHESCo works tirelessly to support those most at risk, providing free energy advice at food banks and community centres throughout the city. Since 2015 BHESCo has been a local energy champion as part of the 'Big Energy Saving Network', and in that time has advised 3,110 residents, helping achieve estimated savings of £249,060.

CASE STUDY: The Montessori Place School, Framfield

In 2016 the Montessori Place purchased a site for a new school in the Sussex countryside. BHESCo were engaged to design an affordable low-carbon energy system for this large, poorly insulated 19th Century property that was not connected to mains gas.

The design proposed by BHESCo incorporated a range of energy saving and energy generating technologies that work in synergy to deliver the most cost-effective and environmentally sustainable solution over time. Combined, our energy interventions will reduce annual carbon emissions from 113 tonnes per year to 23 tonnes per year (79% decrease).

- 27 kW solar PV
- 300mm loft insulation
- 7kW air source heat pump
- 87kW ground source heat pump
- 13 boreholes (120m deep)
- Underfloor heating
- 106 LED lamps
- 38 efficient radiators
